Tax Relief CHY3 forms have been sent out recently to Parishioners. You wont have received one if you filled in and returned one last year as they are valid for 5 years.

- If the person named on the form is eligible for tax please fill in the details (PPS number is essential) sign and date the form and return it to Fr.Jimmy in the envelope provided.
- If the named person is not eligible for tax but another resident 9spouse, adult offspring, etc..) of the household is; cross out the original name and fill in the eligible persons name, their details and signature and return the form in the prepaid envelope. You can also call into the heritage centre on River St (Mon-Wed) and Malcolm Ryan will issue a replacement form with the new details.
- If no one in the Household is eligible for tax the sign the bottom of the letter that was sent pout and return this letter in the envelope provided. We will update the system and you will not receive any forms in future years.
- Some people will also have received additional CHY4 forms relating to donations made in the years 2014 and 2015. Please sign and return these as above, changing the named person if needed.
